### ADAPTECONII RESEARCH FOCUS

Using systems analysis, Johanna will explore the linkages between social trust, the rule of law, state institutions, corruption, legitimacy and the way natural resources are governed. Her aim is to investigate the dynamics governing corruption in management of natural resources in different countries, with case studies in Eastern and Northern Europe. Moreover, she will analyse corruption risks that cause inefficiencies in resource use. In doing so, Johanna hopes to identify the main feedbacks and leverage points which can serve as a foundation for a general conception system dynamics model of corruption.

### EXPERIENCE

Johanna holds a master degree in System Dynamics from University of Bergen and a bachelor degree in Political Science from University of Iceland. During her studies she has mainly been interested in public policy making and environmental policy.
